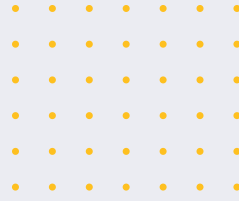

Message from the Head of TTF, Mesut Durukal

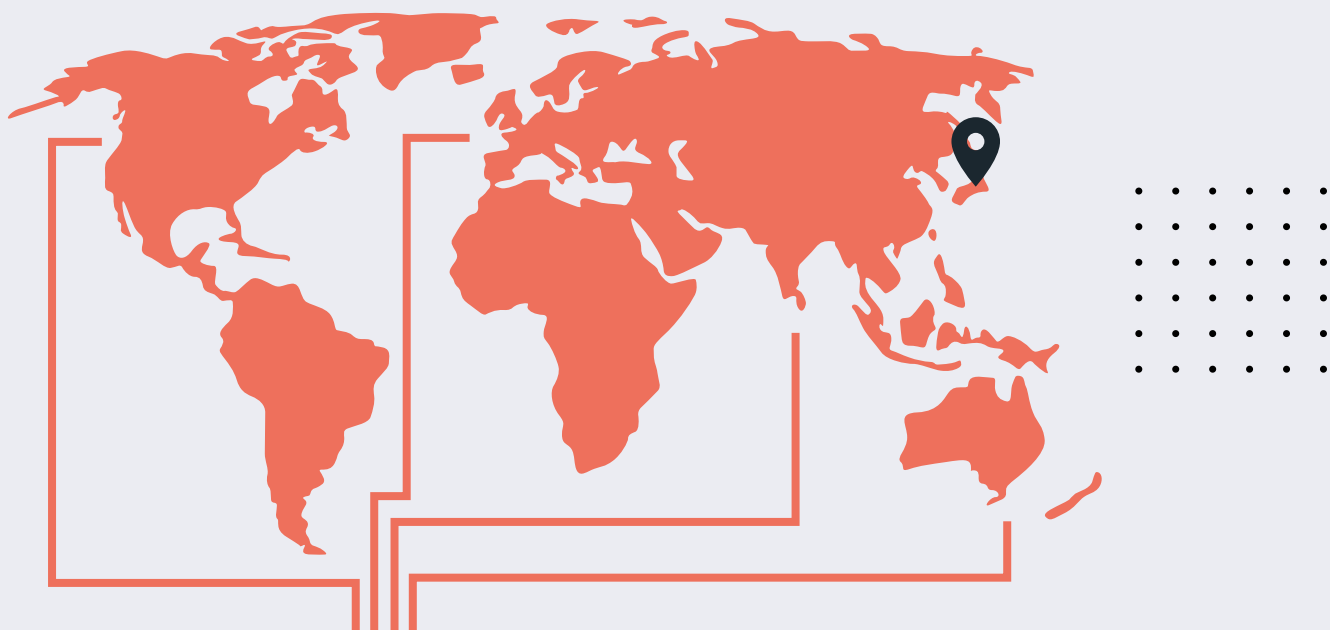
Since relocating to Japan, I always had an ambition to launch an international conference and leverage my expertise in the vibrant setting of this beautiful country.
